

What to do...

1. Work with a partner.
2. One person writes a number between 10 and 100, e.g. 24.
3. They add the two digits, e.g. $2 + 4 = 6$
4. If the answer is 9, the person scores a point!
5. Keep taking turns and playing.
6. The first person to reach a score of ten is the winner!

Adding to nine!

This activity helps children with their addition. It also reinforces a knowledge of two-digit numbers. Help your child by making them identify clearly each 2-digit number they write.

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3 & 6

$$3 + 6 = 9$$

I've written thirty-six. That'll give me a point!

That's clever. I'm going to write eighty-seven and see what that gives me.
