

What to do...



Bossy boots!

Your child has been learning how to write instructions this term but may need help remembering what bossy language is (commands). Pick up the clothes. Knock before entering etc. Your child is combining many skills when writing like this (thinking of an idea, remembering to make it bossy, thinking of the next word, remembering how to form each letter, setting out the sentences one beneath the other), so the main focus should be on writing instructions rather than on the spelling.

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1. Make a poster for your bedroom door with instructions written on it.
2. What kind of things are people allowed/not allowed to do in your bedroom?
3. Remember to use bossy language, just like in real instructions.
4. Write at least three instructions and include pictures for your poster.
5. Remember to number each instruction.
