

What to do...

Make coin rubbings of your four favourite coins!
Here's how...

1. Take your chosen coin and stick it to the table with a small piece of sellotape or Blu-tack® or plasticene underneath it. This is so that it can't move!
2. Place a piece of paper over the coin.
3. Use a fat wax crayon to rub or scribble fairly hard over the coin. The image of the coin should appear on the paper.
4. Do four coin rubbings and bring them into school.

Coin rubbings

This activity helps children to recognise different coins. Talk to your child about how much each coin will buy – what could you buy with 1p? With £1? etc. It is important that children realise the value of each coin.

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I'm going to use a 20p because I like the shape.
