

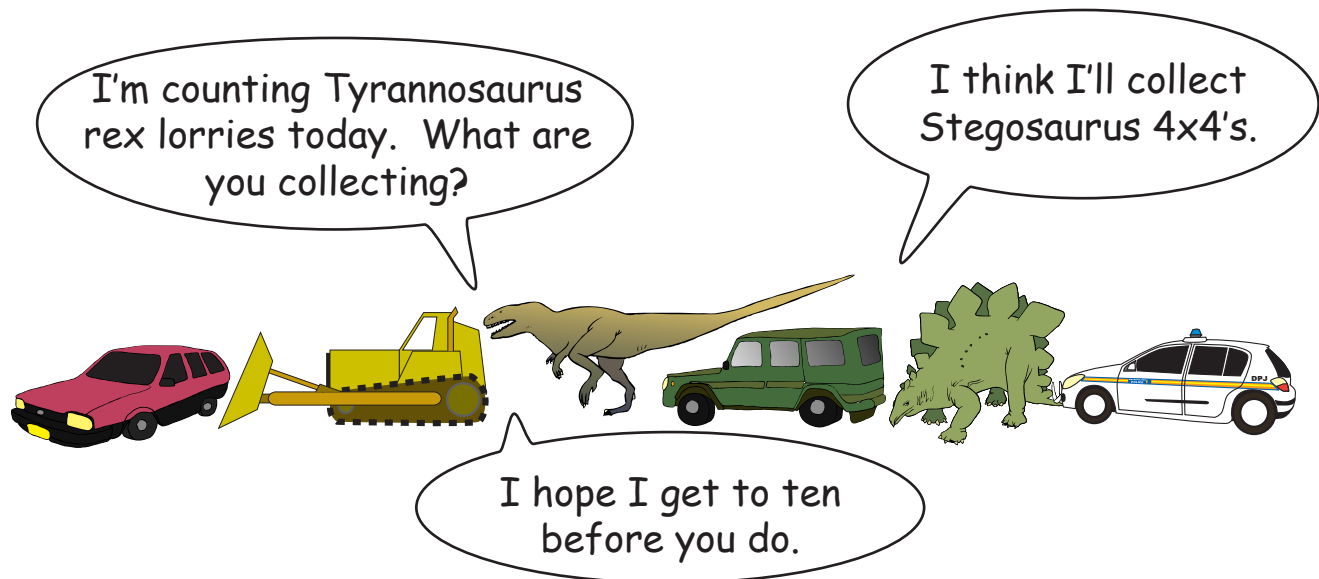
Dinosaurs on your way to school

You will need: Imagination!

What to do:

- Talk about your favourite dinosaurs, how they look and how they move.

- Which car do you think is most like your dinosaur? A sports car? A lorry? A 4x4?
- Choose a dinosaur to count as you make your journey to or from school. May be you could count Tyrannosaurus trucks, Velociraptor sports cars?
- Who can count to ten first?
- Change the game to colours, what colour vehicles are Tyrannosaurus? A silver Stegosaurus? A red Velociraptor? A blue Liplurodon?
- Who can count to ten silver Stegosaurus first?



This activity encourages your child to express their thoughts and ideas through talk. Encourage them to describe their dinosaur vehicles. It also provides an opportunity to practise number skills, counting to ten. Play this game on your journey to and from school or on the way to the supermarket.
