

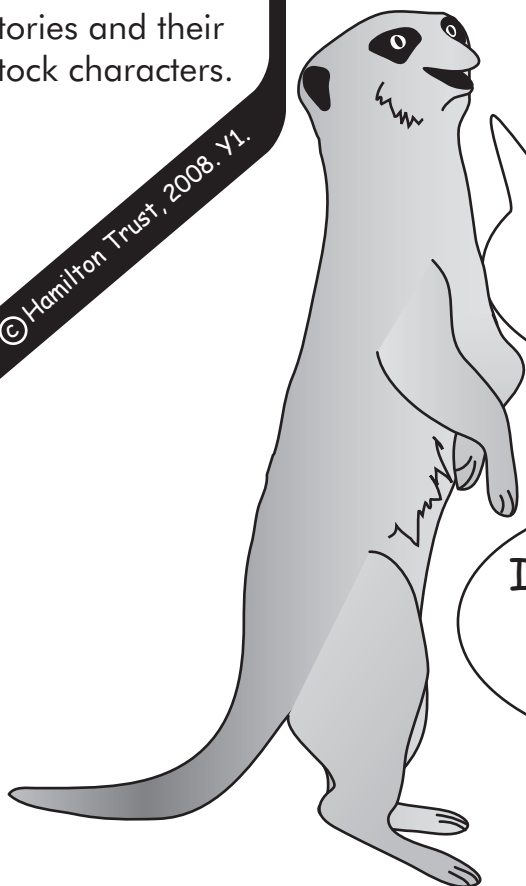
# What to do...

1. Sometimes when a character in a story is speaking, the picture shows them with a speech bubble coming from their mouth.
2. What things do these characters often say in stories?
3. Fill in the speech bubbles on the page provided with the characters' words.
4. Think of a different character from a story you like for the last box.
