

What to do...

How much is your foot worth?

This activity helps to reinforce children's coin recognition at the same time as helping them to count in ones, twos and fives. If you want to extend the activity, try 10p coins. What is the difference in the value of the foot covered in 1ps and in 10ps?

1. Work with a partner to draw round your foot so you have a nice clear outline. (Take your shoe off first!)
2. Cover your foot outline with 1p coins – you can use one or two coins and draw round each one. Make sure your foot is completely covered!
3. How much is your foot worth?
4. Suppose you try 2p coins! How much is your foot worth now?
5. Or 5p coins....?
