

# What to do...

1. The letters are NOT in alphabetical order – they are arranged in groups.
2. Each group of letters is formed in a similar way. There is a pattern to how we write every letter in the group.
3. Write the letters below, starting at the dot/circle and ending at the square.
4. Follow the arrows to write each letter.

## Learning letters

As children learn to write, it is absolutely essential that they learn to form each letter in the correct way. This is not just teachers being fussy! If they do not form each letter correctly, they will be unable to write fast and in a joined up way. This sheet shows how to form each letter.
