

What to do...

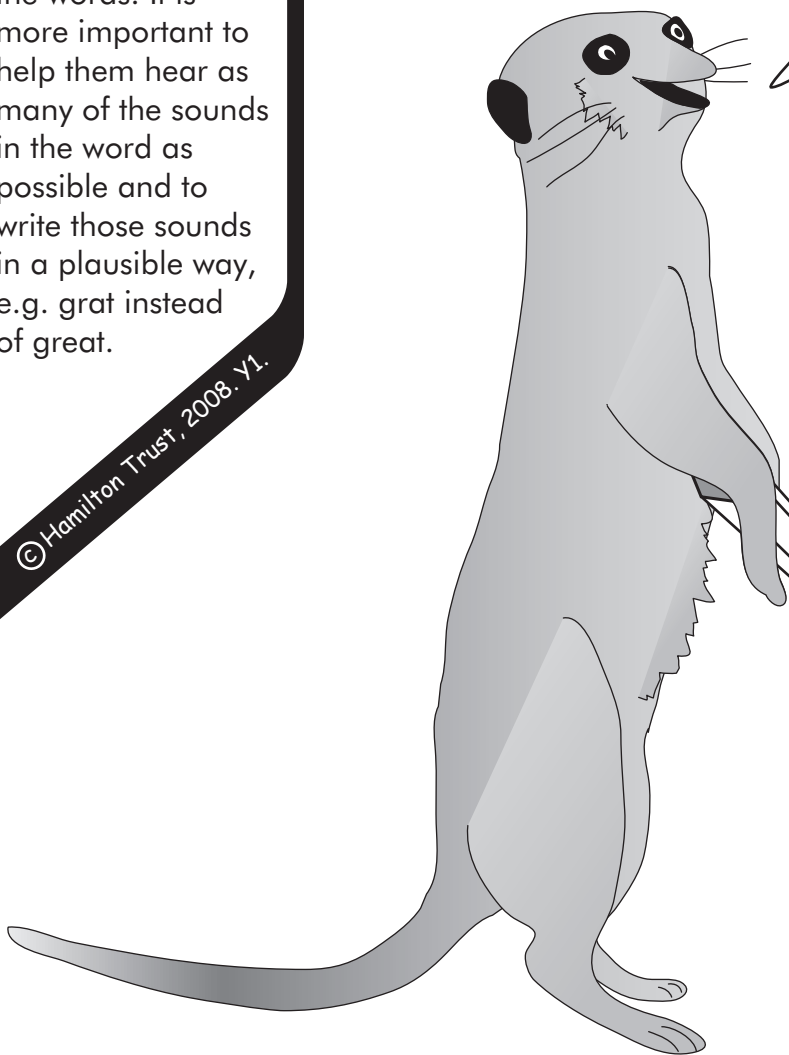
1. Write your name down the left-hand side of a page.
2. Think of a praising word that describes you, starting with each letter in your name.
3. Don't worry if you can't spell the word correctly – have a go at sounding it out!

Name game

This activity helps your child attempt to sound out some more unusual words. It doesn't matter if your child cannot spell all of the words. It is more important to help them hear as many of the sounds in the word as possible and to write those sounds in a plausible way, e.g. grat instead of great.
