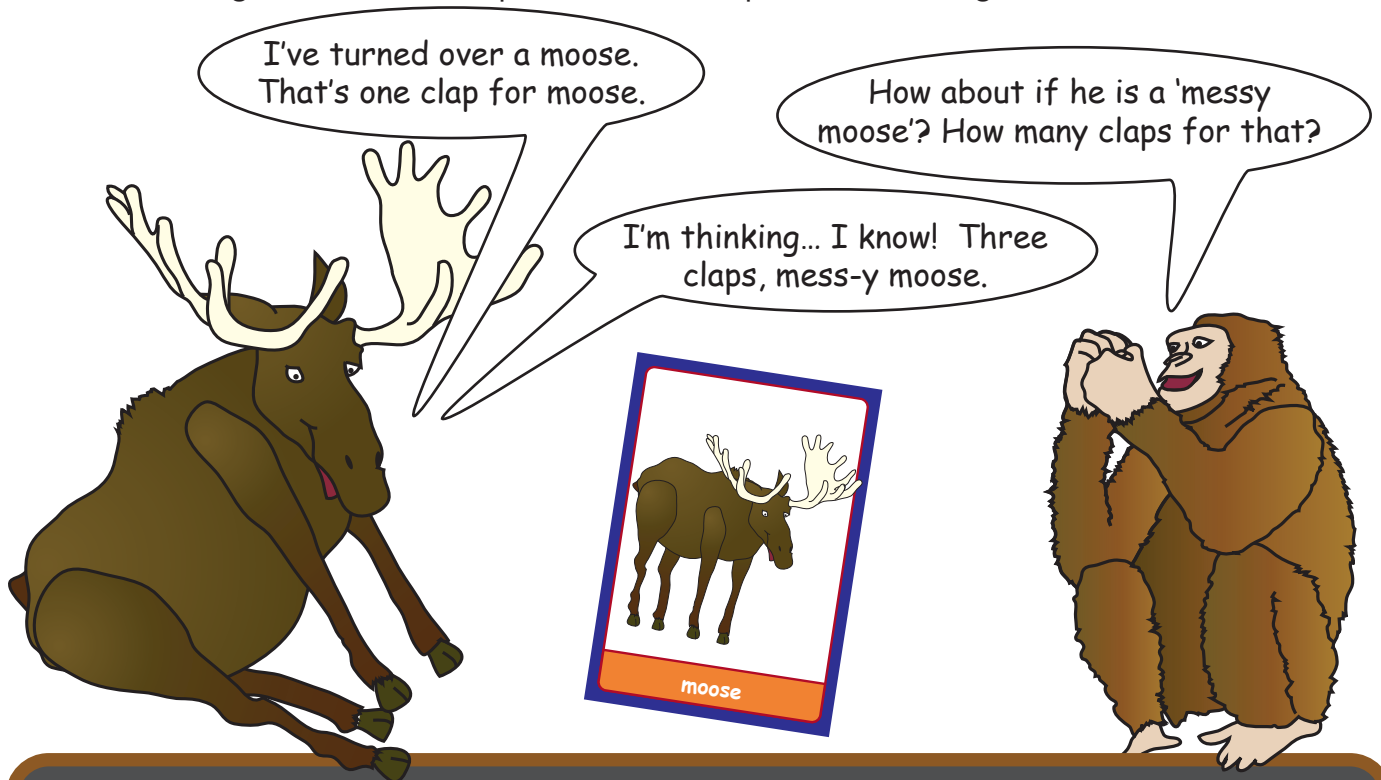


Syllable slithery snakes

You will need: Animal cards.

What to do: ● Stick the animal cards to an old cereal box and cut them out. You could colour them in!

- Lay the cards face down on the table.
- Take turns to pick a card and turn it over.
- Clap out its name in syllables, e.g. tou-can.
- If you are correct, you may keep the card. If not, turn it back over again.
- The winner is the player with the most cards at the end of the game.
- Play again, but this time give each animal a description, e.g. Talking toucan, and clap out the whole phrase. Talk-ing tou-can.

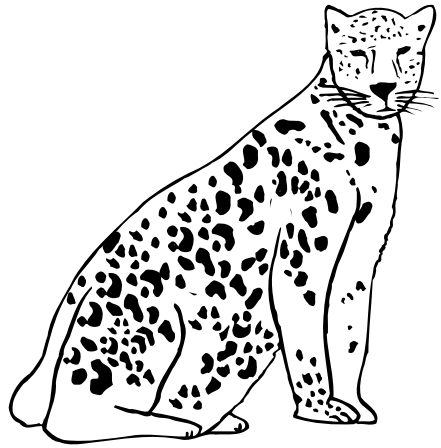


This activity helps your child to hear and say sounds in words. Encourage them to listen to the sounds as they say the animal name and action. Help your child to count the syllables and to think of some animal actions.

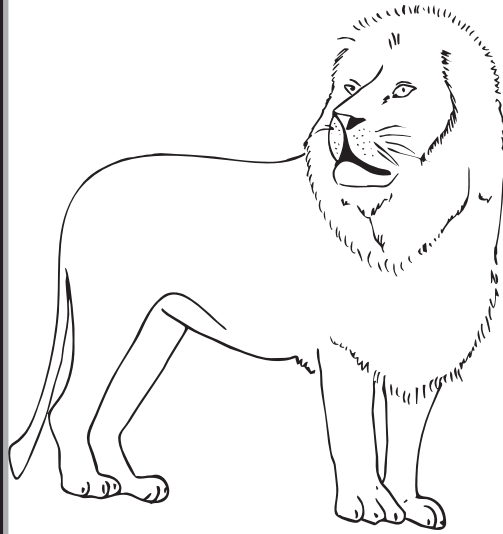
