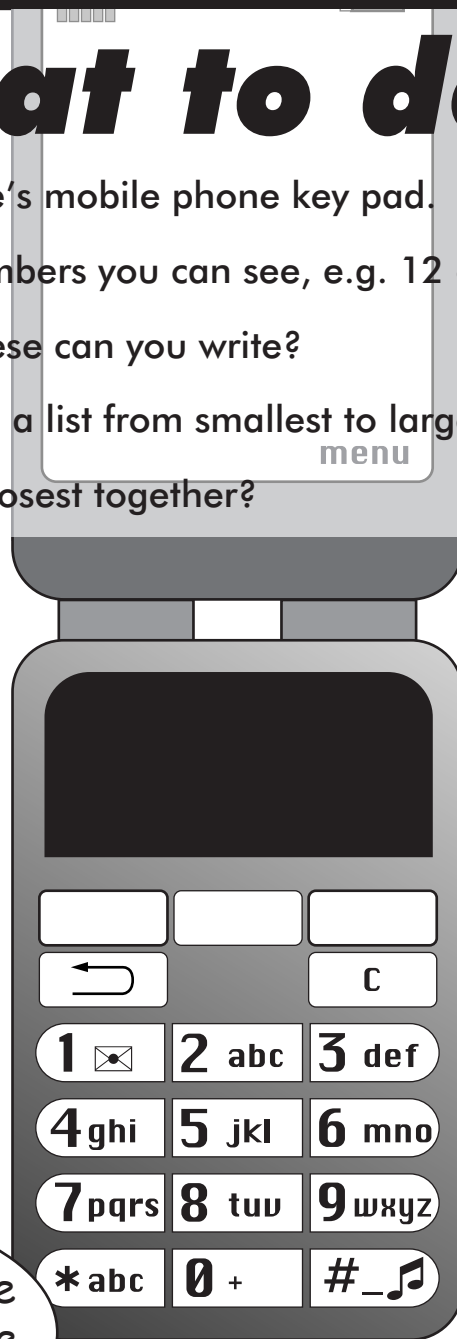


What to do...

1. Look at someone's mobile phone key pad.
2. Write 2-digit numbers you can see, e.g. 12 or 56 or 78.
3. How many of these can you write?
4. Write these all in a list from smallest to largest.
5. Which two are closest together?



Telephone keypads

This activity will help your child to recognise, read and order 2-digit numbers. Help them to find all the obvious numbers (12, 23, 45, 56, 78, 89) and discuss other possible numbers, e.g. 21 or 32. Children may need help writing the numbers in order of size.
